Capacity Building Workshop on MSTRIPES

A three day capacity building workshop on MSTRIPES (Monitoring System for Tiger, Intensive Patrolling & Ecological Status) a smartphone based application has been organized by the Goa Forest Department in collaboration with Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun for forest officers w.e.f. 23/03/2017, at Bhagvan Mahaveer National Park, Mollem.

This application has been developed for Indian conditions by Wildlife Institute of India and is being implemented in Tiger Reserves. The MSTRIPES platform has three modules on Tiger, Intensive Patrolling and Ecological Status covering aspects as diverse as forest protection, wildlife distribution and Man – Animal Conflict. The daily activities undertaken by the fields staff, data collected and the GPS coordinates will be uploaded to a Central Data base and will provide direct access to field information to the Head Quarters in a real time basis.

The resource persons from Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun include Dr. Kaushik Banerjee, Scientist 'D', Shri Ujjwal Kumar, Scientist 'C', Shri. Ashish Prasad and Shri. Ninad, Senior Researchers. In all fifteen officers in the rank of RFO / Dy. RFO and ACFs are participating in this training programme.
