II	Poster Competition	Std : 5 – 7	Hinterlands of Goa- livelihood, flora, fauna	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Best three entries to be evaluated for prizes• Evaluation to be done at district level.• Duration of the event is 1.5 hr.• Drawing Sheet (A3 paper) shall be provided by the department.• Participants are requested to get cardboard, and water colors• Only Watercolours to be used• Names, std., school name should be mentioned on the back side of drawing sheet.• Decision of judges will be final.• If any of the above conditions are not fulfilled the entry will be disqualified.

III	Rangoli Competition	Std : 8 – 10	Forests and wildlife of Goa	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rangoli art size should be of 3 ft x 3 ft. • There will be only one round of competition. • Maximum time to complete the Rangoli is two hours. • Teams will be responsible for arrangement of the material required to prepare Rangoli. • Maximum Strength of a Group should be min 2 & Max 3 members. • Decision of judges will be final. • If any of the above conditions are not fulfilled the entry will be disqualified.
IV	Essay Competition	Std : 11 – 12	Marine ecosystem and its challenges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Best three entries to be evaluated for prizes. • Entries shall be evaluated at district level. • Duration of the event is 2 hrs. • The word limit for the essay is maximum 1000. • All Participants will get participation certificates • Essay must be written in any of the following languages: English, Marathi, Hindi or Konkani. • Decision of judges will be final. • If any of the above conditions are not fulfilled the entry will be disqualified.
